## FULLBLOOD SIMMENTAL FLECKVIEH FEDERATION FSFF JR MEMBER Educational Scholarship Application

The Fullblood Simmental Fleckvieh Federation (FSFF) will award one (1) \$1,000 scholarship in the fall of each year to be used by the recipient during that academic year.

## The following qualifications must be met in order to apply for a scholarship:

- 1. Applicant must be a FSFF JR member in good standing for at least the previous two (2) years.
- 2. Applicant must be at least a high school senior at the time of application. Students are eligible to apply for financial support of their education at an accredited post-secondary vocational/technical school, college, university, or graduate program, up until the final year of their education.
- 3. Applicants are eligible to receive the scholarship only once during their post-secondary school career.
- 4. Application must be typed (handwritten applications will be disqualified).
- 5. Application, letters of recommendation & transcripts must be postmarked by September 1 of each year for consideration.

## Awarding of the scholarship:

- 1. All applications meeting these requirements will be considered by a review team named by the FSFF Board.
- 2. The scholarship will be awarded based on the information submitted in the application, transcripts, and letters of recommendation. Preference will be given to students based on their involvement with agriculture and Fleckvieh Simmental cattle, demonstrated leadership, and plans for future involvement in the field of agriculture.
- 3. Scholarship funds will be forwarded directly to the school at the which the student is enrolled, by December 1 of the year in which it is awarded.
