Discussion-

- o World Congress- based in Fort Worth, TX and will include 2 farm tours. Nikki Gress will talk with Fred and will report back to Board re: availability and cost.
 - o FSFF can display a booth, waiting on Fred to provide cost details.
- Ozarks Farm Fest- There are approx 800 booths/displays as well as live cattle displays. If Grady is able to take cattle, he will split the cost with the FSFF & display booth in his area.
 - o Grady's update (emailed to Brandy prior to call)-
 - \$400 for inside booth space. He's waiting to hear if any are available.
 - \$175 per base cattle exhibit that allows up to 4 head in the display area. Venue works off of a waiting list each year.
 - Grady prefers a livestock display over the inside booth & is on the waiting list. Might require two spots to display cattle and the FSFF booth.
 - Is the Board willing to approve up to \$175 in the event 1-2 spots are made available to Grady?
 - Board tabled until next meeting.

2018 Annual Meeting

- The Board discussed two possible venues-
 - #1- Having it at the Little Creek Farm facility in Starkville in conjunction with the Magnolia Classic sale- same as has been done the past 2 years. Dr. Davis is agreeable to hosting the meeting there on Oct 19th (the sale is Satuday, Oct 20th).
 - #2- Having it in Fort Worth, TX in conjuction with the World Congress (Sept 24th Oct 1st).
 - Nikki Gress spoke with Fred FSFF would potentially have to pay room fee, catering, AV rent, etc. Let Fred know what FSFF needs, and he will provide price estimates.
 Could possibly have a Friday or Saturday evening meeting, but it would have to be done around a specific meeting that has not yet been officially schedule.
 - o Board discussion-
 - May be too pricey, may be hard to work FSFF event(s) into World Congress schedule, would meeting be well attended by FSFF members?

Steven Jensen motioned for FSFF 2018 Annual Meeting to be held at Little Creek Farm in Starkville, MS on Friday, Oct 19th with similar format to prior years.

Randy Plaugher seconded.

Motion passed unanimously.

- Nikki will contact caterer- something similar to last 2 years.
- Board agreed to again do a silent auction to offset cost of meal- start Friday afternoon, end Saturday before start of Magnolia Classic sale.
- Youth Photo Contest- Board agreed to do again similar to last year.
- Speakers- Board to present ideas for discussion/decision at next meeting.

2018 FSFF Fundraising

- Grady Reach emailed a list of ideas to Brandy prior to call; Brandy presented for Board discussion-
 - Publish a NICE (hard back) book of Fleckvieh cattle in limited quantities and make available for purchase at certain sales/events-
 - Would need quality, digital images. Possibly use a site like snapfish to compile & produce the books. Would FSFF get enough interest for pics and sales?
 - o Flush sale- ask breeders to donate a flush from one donor (for use of donor only). Semen and all related flush costs to be responsibility of buyer. Perhaps offer in an online format.
 - o Semen sale- same as flush sale but with semen.
 - Better to do in conjunction with a production sale but then walk fine line with other consignors → don't want to offend or take away from success of their consignments.
 - Phone solicitation is better received than email or newsletters, but based on "herd in a tank" response, the expectation for member participation/donation is low.
 - Canadian sales? Could FSFF do anything there? Glenn to ask around to gauge interest.
- Other fundraising topics presented on the call
 - o Brandy suggested offering "limited 20XX edition" custom FSFF belt buckles- sell one at USA sale/event and one at a Canadian sale/event? Could also offer a less elaborate, undated buckle design to membership for purchase? Order from vendor as needed based on orders received.
 - Offer design allowing buyer to engrave his/her name or ranch on the buckle?
 - Need to look into pricing. Anne-Marie uses Show Time Awards for NAILE buckles.
- Will auction 1 or both necklaces made by Anne-Marie at the start of BHR's Designer's Classic in May.
- Steve Jensen is offering a ³/₄ Fleckvieh heifer in BHR's Designer's Classic as a 50/50 fundraiser lot.

2018 FSFFjr Scholarship Fundraising

- Tabled until next meeting- Board members asked to think of ideas
 - o 2016- 4 frozen genetic sale lots generated \$3,225 at the Magnolia Classic
 - o 2017- 'Herd in a Tank' sale lot generated \$2,400 at the Magnolia Classic
 - o Presented the idea of endowments at the 2017 Annual Meeting. Also published the information in the 2018 Membership Directory. No inquiries to date.

2018 Fred Schuetze Award

- Nominations needed ASAP in order to present award at BHR's Designer's Classic Sale.
 - o Board discussion- award does not "have" to be presented at BHR's spring sale but is a nice gesture to do so given the award is named for Fred Schuetze. Mention of the award can also be made at the FSFF Annual Meeting for those who are not present at BHR.
